Music Faculty (Teaching Associate - Voice Teacher)

University of Illinois at Chicago

Part-time beginning August 16, 2021

The School of Theatre and Music at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) invites applications from qualified individuals to serve as a Teaching Associate and teach voice students.

Responsibilities: provide private instruction in voice to students enrolled in the BA and BM degree programs.

Minimum qualifications: bachelor's degree in music or music education; proven excellence in the teaching of voice that values a broad range of repertoires, styles, and composers; a minimum of five years of experience with students from diverse musical and personal backgrounds; a career as a professional soloist and ensemble singer; keyboard skills sufficient to regularly accompany lessons; proficiency in the sung pronunciation of American dialectal English, British English, French, Italian, German, Spanish, Latin, and/or other languages; proficiency in the International Phonetic Alphabet, and the ability to incorporate the teaching of diction in the vocal lesson.

Preferred qualifications: graduate degree in voice; experience teaching at the university level; and a record of successful student recruitment and program development.

UIC is a Carnegie Research 1 university that enrolls over 30,000 students on a 240-acre site one mile west of Chicago's Loop. The School of Theatre & Music provides innovative, rigorous, and comprehensive academic and performance programs to a highly diverse student body. One of four units in the College of Architecture, Design, and the Arts, STM enrolls about 100 undergraduate students in music programs and about 125 undergraduate students in theatre. The faculty consists of performing artists and scholars. There are about 30 full-time faculty and about 40 part-time faculty. The School offers coursework leading to a BA in Music, BA in Music Business, BM in Music Performance, BM in Jazz Studies, BFA in Acting, BA in Theatre and Performance, and BA in Theatre Design, Production, and Technology. Music ensembles include choirs, concert bands, jazz ensembles, orchestra, athletic band, chamber groups, jazz combos, among others. For more information, go to theatreandmusic.uic.edu.

Finalists will later be asked to provide link to videos of a performance and a voice lesson.
