Two-week camps

UIC professors and renowned guest instructors will work with theatre and music students of all levels. Jazz and theatre students will work independently for most of each day. They will also come together for lunch to participate in special lectures, workshops, and field trips, and for final performances. In addition, jazz and theatre students will work together in small groups to devise 60-second original performances based on a common theme.

Jazz Camp

Designed for students with a serious interest in jazz. Students develop small group improvisation skills working in combos under the tutelage of UIC jazz faculty. Each week will include master classes, interactive performance forums, and college-level classes in improvisation, theory, history and listening skills. Students should have some experience playing in ensembles.

Theatre Camp

Designed for students who have a strong interest in writing/devising new work. Collaborate as an ensemble to create an original work, led by a Lookingglass Theatre Company founding ensemble member. Workshops and master classes in voice, movement and design are led by UIC faculty. No prior theatre experience necessary.

One-week camp

Symphonic Band Camp

Designed for students who want an intensive five-day musical experience that allows them to grow musically in a fun and exciting learning environment. Students will expand repertoire through intensive rehearsal with one of two wind bands and develop skills in instrumental master classes. The camp culminates with a concert at the end of camp featuring literature studied throughout the week. Students should have some experience playing in ensembles.
