## **AUDITION TIME SLOTS**

The audition consists of 3 parts:

- 1. **Short vocalization** to hear your range.
- 2. **Prepared piece of your choosing.** Please prepare 1-2 minutes of a jazz or contemporary piece that demonstrates your style and musicality. This may be performed acapella, with a backing track, or piano accompaniment. If you would like piano accompaniment, please bring sheet music with chord changes for Professor Allgood to play.
- 3. Prepared excerpt. Please prepare your typical voice part (SATB) for the provided excerpt. If you are unsure of your voice part, please contact Professor Allgood for guidance. You will be asked to sing the excerpt acapella, and with accompaniment. You will also be asked to apply feedback from Professor Allgood. This part of the audition will be used to evaluate your preparation and ability to take direction, both of which are essential parts of being in the ensemble.
